Reflexology



This 21 hour course offers reflex techniques for vitalizing the whole body with emphasis on activating the channels of elimination, drainage of the lymphatics and detoxification of metabolic wastes stored in the tissues of the feet, organs, glands and nervous system. Reflexology involves distal stimulation on the feet, hands or ears to release metabolic wastes that impede the nerve terminals in the feet and hands. Students will also learn: the importance of detoxifying metabolic wastes stored in tissues of the body, and adjunctive measures to support detoxification, magnesium absorption, immune support and relaxation. Treatment adjuncts include: a Liver Flush, Polarity Tea, Fresh juices, Essential oils, Hydrotherapy and Epsom salt foot bath.
