Craniosacral Therapy I



In this 30 hr course, students will move through a progression of twelve lessons to optimize the cranial wave movement pattern within the body. The lessons include the anatomy and gentle holds specific to the sacrum, occipital, frontal, parietal, sphenoid and temporal bones, as well as the horizontal fascial planes, the fourth ventricle of the brain and Dural tube of the spinal cord. Students will learn to sit in silence, deepen communication between self and client and interface with the oceanic environment of the cerebrospinal fluid with gentle touch contact. As students monitor and provide a fulcrum for the underlying tissue a healing state may arise known as "Stillpoint", followed by deeper relaxation, revitalization and integration within the body, mind and spirit.
