The California Private Postsecondary Education Act (CPPEA) requires under section 94910 of CPPEA that a school provide information for each program offered in regards to completion rates, placement rates, licensure exam passage rates, and salary/wage information. The following information is data compiled for January 1, 2011 to July 1, 2011 newly enrolled students and 2011 carry over students enrolled from July 1-Dec 31, 2010. There is not a state licensure exam and therefore we do not report statistics for a passage rate. However, all of the SBBTI students who have taken the National Certification Board exam have passed.

**Wages: Per phone conversations with employed graduates their number of weekly sessions varies greatly from 1 to 20 and hourly rates vary from \$13 to \$80. Thus the annual income is anywhere from less than \$5000 to more than \$25000.** We are unable to provide accurate annual wage statistics at this point. A Massage Practitioner's initiative and ability to attract and hold regular clients are key factors in determining his or her earnings.

Statistics were gathered by cross referencing our student data files with responses from questionnaires and phone calls. To obtain a list of employment positions determined to be within the field with regards to job placement of graduates, please ask the school director or registrar or check our job placement board.

Wage and salary data can also be gathered using the data from the Employment Development Department, Labor Market Information Division. (<https://www.labormarketinfo.edd.ca.gov/>).

Currently the EDD listing shows the hourly mean for California as \$18.96. Information regarding general salary and placement statistics may be available from government sources or from the institution but it is not equivalent to actual performance data.
