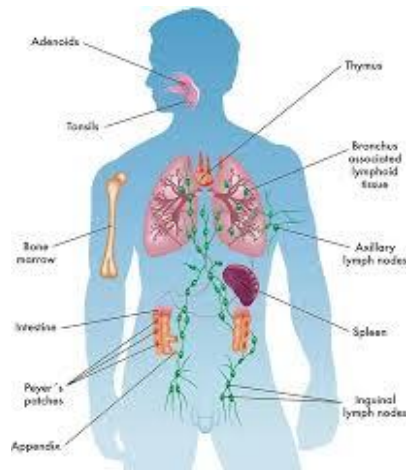


Immune Physiology & Pathology



This 32-hour course covers the functions and pathologies involving the circulatory, lymphatic, skin, respiratory, integumentary, digestive and urinary systems. Students will learn the signs and symptoms of common pathologies impacting these systems as well as indications, contra-indications, and areas of caution. The course covers effective strategies and anecdotal stories of treating and resolving many pathologies with bodywork technique and adjunctive measures including: Reflexology, Acupressure, Essential oils, Magnesium applications, Castor oil, Far Infra red heat, probiotics, and “your own perfect medicine.” Dry brushing Clinical pathologies addressed include: asthma, autoimmune deficiency syndromes, bronchitis, cardio-vascular disease, cancer, chronic pulmonary obstructive disease COVID 19, edema, headaches, hiatal hernia, high blood pressure, influenza, irritable bowel syndrome, kidney disease, liver disease, open wounds/sores, pneumonia, urinary tract infection, and assorted.
