Myofascial Release



This 60 hour module offers treatment protocols for addressing the myofascia, using cross fiber, longitudinal releases, as well as Proprioceptor Neuromuscular Facilitation PNF and Orthopedic assessment of posture and longitudinal fascial "anatomy trains". This course will offer the myofascial approach of Tom Myers. Myofascial Release addresses restrictions in the web of connective tissue that supports, connects and protects the muscles, nerves and joints. Myofascial Release may increase flexibility and decrease pain. Students will learn to recognize distortions in the myofascia, the mechanisms of tissue repair and healing within the myofascial system. Students will learn how to give a stand - alone MFR session, integrate MFR techniques with Swedish, and practice self-care on their own myofascial system. The course includes three clinics, in which students will give the general public full myofascial sessions.
