Pregnancy Massage



This 30 hour course prepares body workers to provide support for women in childbearing years, mothers to be and prenatal/infants. Throughout time, many traditional cultures have utilized prenatal bodywork as a means to create peaceful beginnings for parents and child. Students will learn a wide range of bodywork techniques including:

- Acupressure points specific to each trimester as well as labor
- Side Posture and Semi Reclined Swedish Massage
- Deep Tissue Muscle Sculpting for area specific work
- Deep Perineal Balancing for releasing trigger points in the perineum in preparation for easeful labor
- Polarity Therapy for hormonal balancing
